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**James Franco** (Palo Alto, California, Usa, 1978) ha studiato all'Università della California, alla Columbia University e alla New York University's Tisch School of the Arts. Interpretò diversi film di successo (tra cui la trilogia di *Spider Man* di Sam Raimi; *Milk* di Gus Van Sant; *127 Hours* di Danny Boyle, per il quale ha ricevuto una nomination agli Oscar; *Spring Breakers* di Harmony Korine), è regista, sceneggiatore e produttore con la sua Rabbit Bandini Productions. Con il cortometraggio *The Feast of Stephen* (2009) ha vinto il Teddy Award alla Berlinale. Alla Mostra di Venezia (dove nel 2013 ha partecipato in concorso con *Child of God*) ha ricevuto il Jaeger-LeCoultre Glory to the Filmmaker Award nel 2014 e due anni dopo il premio Fondazione Mimmo Rotella 2016 per *In Dubious Battle - Il coraggio degli ultimi*. Nel 2018, Franco ha conquistato un altro Golden Globe per *The Disaster Artist*, proiettato anche nella sezione After Hours del Torino Film Festival 2017.

**James Franco** (Palo Alto, CA, USA, 1978) studied at UCLA, at Columbia University and New York University's Tisch School of the Arts. He performed in several features, including Sam Raimi's *Spider Man* trilogy, Gus Van Sant's *Milk*, Danny Boyle's *127 Hours*, for which he received an Academy Award nomination, and Harmony Korine's *Spring Breakers*. He is also a director, screenwriter, and a producer with his company Rabbit Bandini Productions. His short *The Feast of Stephen* (2009) won a Teddy Award at the Berlinale. He participated to the Venice Film Festival in 2013 with *Child of God*, receiving the Jaeger-LeCoultre Glory to the Filmmaker Award in 2014, and with *In Dubious Battle* in 2016, winning the Fondazione Mimmo Rotella Award. In 2018, Franco grabbed another Golden Globe win for *The Disaster Artist*. The film was screened at 2017 TFF in the section After Hours.
